Today, Rick Tice, Ed Hendrix, Ike Byrd and the undersigned, representing BellSouth, spoke with Judy Argentieri and Jim Lichford of the Common Carrier Bureau's Tariff Division via telephone regarding the above captioned proceeding. The discussion centered around the issue of whether BellSouth had adequately described the LIDB query service in its tariff. Specifically, BellSouth discussed the frequency, nature and priority of database updates and liability for erroneous information in the database; references to technical publications and updating the tariff to reflect the latest revisions in technical publications; liability for fraudulent use of credit cards; and call gapping and other technical issues.
