Dear Ms. Dortch:

On July 31, 2018, Staci Pies (Google LLC), Michael Fitzpatrick and Vijay Venkateswaran (General Electric and IIoT Coalition) and Stephen Coran (counsel to Wireless Internet Service Providers Association) met with the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau and Office of Engineering and Technology staff listed below to discuss issues related to competitive bidding for Priority Access Licenses in the Citizens Broadband Radio Service (“CBRS”).

The conversation focused on auction design techniques that would enable a successful auction among a large number of bidders with diverse business models, including the proposals outlined in the ex parte letter submitted last August by economist Paul Milgrom. The Commission’s policy decisions have historically driven the design for Commission auctions, and we believe the same approach should be taken here. We expressed our strong interest in remaining engaged with the Commission on auction design issues as the pending CBRS proceeding is finalized.
