Second Progress Report

South Central Communications, Inc., formerly South Central Wireless, LLC d/b/a South Central Communications (“SCC”), is a Tier III CMRS service provider in rural Utah that is a wholly-owned subsidiary of South Central Utah Telephone Association, Inc., a rural telephone cooperative.<sup>1</sup> SCC provides commercial mobile radio service (“CMRS”) via stations KNLG223 and WQBL704, licensed in the Broadband Personal Communications Service. SCC participates in a switch sharing arrangement operated by Rural Independent Network Alliance, LLC (“RINA”) in Roosevelt, Utah. Consistent with its Initial Implementation Plan and First Progress Report filed in PS Docket No. 07-114 on August 3, 2017, the representation and statements in which are reiterated herein, SCC has filed all required reports and compliance filings and remains on course in its plan for implementation of E911 and meeting the indoor location benchmarks established in the Fourth R&O.

- SCC currently provides E911 service and delivers Automatic Location Information (ALI) data to PSAPs in Kane, Garfield, Sevier and Wayne Counties in Utah.<sup>2</sup>
- SCC is filing Live Call Data reports on a semi-annual basis.
- SCC has entered into an agreement with Test Bed, LLC to analyze its live 9-1-1 call data and to facilitate the SCC network’s compliance with the indoor accuracy requirements.
  - Based on a recent 50m Accuracy Report, SCC’s rural network is identifying the x/y (horizontal) location within 50 meters for more than 50% of all 9-1-1 calls.
- SCC’s network can make uncompensated barometric data (*i.e.*, vertical location) available to PSAPs from any handset capable of delivering barometric sensor data.
- SCC is committed to timely meeting the increasingly stringent horizontal location accuracy benchmarks going forward.

<sup>1</sup> In a *pro forma* transaction on November 1, 2017, South Central Wireless, LLC assigned its licenses for Broadband PCS stations KNLG223 and WQBL704 to its affiliate, South Central Communications, Inc. The transaction was reported to the Commission in the notification in File No. 0008013112, filed November 30, 2017.

<sup>2</sup> SCC no longer provides CMRS service in Piute County, Utah, due to economic considerations. CMRS service in Piute County continues to be provided by Verizon.
