**SECOND REQUEST FOR ACTION ON
PETITION FOR CLARIFICATION
OR, IN THE ALTERNATIVE, RECONSIDERATION**

On June 28, 2018, WorldNet Telecommunications, Inc. (“WorldNet”) filed a petition with the Commission asking the Commission clarify or, in the alternative, reconsider its Order and Notice of Proposed Rulemaking released in this proceeding on May 29, 2018 (“Puerto Rico Funding Order”).¹ Specifically, WorldNet sought assurance and/or clarification that it will be afforded an equivalent financial benefit as that afforded by the Commission to other Puerto Rico providers when it determined in the Puerto Rico Funding Order not to offset such advance payments against future support. By December 2018, nearly six months later, WorldNet had received no action from the Commission on its petition. Accordingly, on December 17, 2019, WorldNet filed a request for action on its petition.

To date, over a year after WorldNet filed its petition, the Commission has still not responded to or acted upon WorldNet’s pending petition, leaving WorldNet without the full amount of emergency funding that the Commission ostensibly intended to provide to WorldNet as it mounts its recovery from the 2017 hurricanes that devastated Puerto Rico. Every day that passes

without the relief requested in WorldNet's petition unduly and unnecessarily prejudices WorldNet and its Puerto Rico customers in their continuing hurricane recovery efforts. To be clear, WorldNet seeks no special treatment nor advantage here, but rather, it seeks to be put in the same position as all other carriers. To this end, WorldNet respectfully requests that the Commission take immediate action on WorldNet's petition, granting it in full and urgently providing WorldNet the full measure of hurricane recovery funding that the Commission ostensibly intended for WorldNet to receive.
