**JOINT MOTION TO DISMISS FORMAL COMPLAINT
WITH PREJUDICE**

Complainant AT&T Corp. (“AT&T”) and Defendant Great Lakes Communication Corp. (“GLCC”) hereby jointly move for dismissal of the above-captioned formal complaint. In support thereof, AT&T and GLCC state as follows:

1. AT&T filed a Formal Complaint against GLCC in the above-captioned proceeding on August 16, 2016 (“Formal Complaint”).
2. AT&T and GLCC have formally settled the disputes giving rise to the Formal Complaint. Accordingly, AT&T and GLCC have agreed to seek dismissal of the Formal Complaint as to all claims and defenses asserted therein, in order to dispose of all issues and controversies in the Formal Complaint.
3. Under these circumstances, the parties respectfully submit that dismissal is both necessary and appropriate. Dismissal of the Formal Complaint will “serve the public interest by promoting the private resolution of disputes, eliminating the need for further litigation, and conserving the resources of the parties and th[e] Commission.” *Charter Commc’ns v. Ga. Power Co.*, 31 FCC Rcd. 3453, ¶ 3 (2016).

CONCLUSION

For the foregoing reasons, AT&T and GLCC jointly move for the dismissal of the Formal Complaint with prejudice.
