Dear Ms. Dortch:

In various submissions filed in this proceeding, CenturyLink, Inc. (“CenturyLink”) and Level 3 Communications, Inc. (“Level 3,” and together with CenturyLink, the “Applicants”) have reported that a fiber-based competitor is located within 0.1 mile of a significant number of 2-1 locations in CenturyLink’s ILEC region.¹ In response to a request from the staff of the Commission’s Wireline Competition Bureau (the “Bureau”), the Applicants submit herein Highly Confidential data [Bates Number CTLLVLT-000155] demonstrating the extent to which demand in those locations meets or exceeds the approximate equivalent of two DS-3 circuits.²

The document submitted herewith is Highly Confidential and therefore is marked “HIGHLY CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION — SUBJECT TO PROTECTIVE ORDER IN

² The most recent location analysis submitted by the Applicants demonstrates that there are a total of 529 2-1 locations in which a fiber-based competitor is not at the location, but is within 0.1 mile of that location. The Applicants are submitting herewith Highly Confidential demand data for 454 of those 2-1 locations. Of these locations, the data being submitted shows that demand in these locations meets or exceeds the approximate equivalent of two DS-3 circuits in 452, or 99.6 percent, of these 454 locations. Applicants are continuing to collect demand data for the remaining 75 locations and expect to supplement this submission with that information shortly.
