**Re: Notice of Consolidation of Commonly-Owned Study Areas  
Telapex, Inc., Holding Company for Delta Telephone Company, Inc. 280452  
And Franklin Telephone Company, Inc. 280454 in Mississippi**

Dear Mr. Palmer,

Telapex, Inc. ("Telapex" or "Company") is the holding company for two incumbent local exchange carriers in Mississippi, Delta Telephone Company, Inc. ("Delta") which has a Study Area Code of 280452 and Franklin Telephone Company, Inc. ("Franklin") which has a Study Area Code of 280454. Telapex elected Alternative Connect America Cost Model ("A-CAM") support on a statewide basis for Delta and Franklin.<sup>1</sup>

Telapex hereby notifies the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC" or "Commission") that effective January 1, 2018, the Company will consolidate the two study areas with Franklin being the surviving entity. Pursuant to FCC precedent, no prior approval is required when a holding company is consolidating existing study areas in the same state.<sup>2</sup>


