On Wednesday August 3, 2016 Larry Reeder, Emergency Services Solutions Architect, Thomas Ginter, Emergency Service Sales Engineer, and I of Bandwidth.com, Inc. (“Bandwidth”) met with David Furth, David Siehl, and Tim May of the Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau and Dr. Henning Schultzrinne of Columbia University.

During our meeting we discussed the Commission’s and Bandwidth’s efforts to support emergency service capabilities for TRS/VRS services in an evolving and increasingly mobile IP environment. Bandwidth used the attached presentation to discuss how it has supported its VRS service provider customers and their end-user customers with emergency call routing capabilities historically and how these services are changing. Bandwidth drew comparisons to work it is doing in the mobile VoIP space as a potential avenue for improvements to VRS emergency calling capabilities as well.
