Entertainment Media Trust (“EMT”), by counsel files this status report regarding the captioned matter.

EMT is continuing to engage in the early stages of the discovery process. It filed its Response to the Enforcement Bureau’s (“Bureau”) Request for Admissions on July 31, 2019 pursuant to the July 23, 2019 Order granting EMT and the Bureau an extended deadline within which to respond to the other party’s request for admissions. EMT also received the Bureau’s Objections and Responses to EMT’s Request for Admissions (“Objections and Responses”) on July 26, 2019. EMT is in the process of reviewing the Bureau’s Objections and Responses and how those responses will impact EMT’s discovery process going forward. EMT also expects to receive the Bureau’s first set of interrogatories in the next two weeks.

Apart from discovery matters, EMT filed a Motion to Adopt Protective Order on August 5, 2019. The Motion was filed on behalf of all the parties to the proceeding after consultation with and approval of the filing by the other parties. As the Motion indicates, the parties agree that a protective order is appropriate in this proceeding.
