PLEASE NOTE:

- All references to the Danvers, MA 5ESS switch are associated with CLI code DNVSMAHIDS0 and will not be repeated throughout this notice.
- All references to the Lowell, MA Packet End Office (PEO) switch are associated with CLI code LWLLMAAPPSA and will not be repeated throughout this notice.

Description of the Planned Network Change(s):

The Verizon Danvers, MA 5ESS switch, located at 63 High Street, Danvers, MA 01923, will be retired and removed from the network after all traffic served by this switch is migrated to the Verizon Lowell, MA PEO switch located at 115 Appleton Street, Lowell, MA 01852. All traffic to be migrated includes, but is not limited to, Inter-LATA (ACCESS/FG-B-D/CLEC/IXC), wireless, and paging traffic.

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact(s) of the Planned Change(s):

Competitive local exchange carriers (CLECs), interexchange carriers (IXCs, IECs), wireless carriers, and paging carriers will need to secure new trunk groups built to the Lowell, MA PEO switch or have existing trunk groups to that switch augmented. Carriers that are code holders for access connectivity in the Danvers, MA 5ESS switch will be required to reposition the codes to the Lowell, MA PEO switch.

All ASRs for the Lowell, MA PEO switch must be received no later than January 4, 2019, in order to provide sufficient time to migrate the traffic described above. These direct end office trunk (DEOT) interconnections will support traffic migration for the Danvers, MA 5ESS switch prior to its eventual decommissioning. Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) change effective dates will be posted prior to decommissioning of the Danvers, MA 5ESS switch (**on or after February 15, 2019**). This will serve to guide interconnect re-routes of traffic for the eight (8) native codes currently served by the Danvers, MA 5ESS switch to reflect the Lowell, MA PEO switch as the new home switch. All ASRs for the Lowell, MA PEO switch must carry the project code of **NTMTDDNVSMAHIDS0**.
