Dear Ms. Dortch:

On August 6, 2019, David Field, Chairman, President and Chief Executive Officer of Entercom Communications Corp. ("Entercom"), Sarah Harris, Entercom's Vice President of Social Impact, and I met with Commissioner O'Rielly, his Chief of Staff and Media Legal Advisor, Joel Miller, and Legal Intern, Christopher McGillen, to discuss certain issues raised in the above-captioned proceedings.

We discussed the FCC's 2018 Quadrennial Regulatory Review and reiterated our support of the proposals set forth by the National Association of Broadcasters to modify the local radio ownership rule. We also noted our filing of joint reply comments in the docket.

During the meeting, we also expressed our concern that certain of the modifications to the LPFM technical rules proposed in the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in MB Docket No. 19-193 could bring increased congestion to the FM dial leading to interference to full power stations.
