Dear Ms. Dortch:

On April 8, 2016, CenturyLink submitted a written ex parte in the above-referenced proceedings. The ex parte describes extensive competition that characterizes the high-capacity marketplace. The April 8<sup>th</sup> submission included highly confidential information and was filed in both non-redacted and redacted formats. The April 8<sup>th</sup> ex parte was attached to a cover letter that included an appendix providing justification for highly confidential treatment for certain of the information. The highly confidential information is protected from public disclosure pursuant to the terms of the *Tariff Investigation Protective Order* (Appendix B to the Order and Protective Orders in WC Docket No. 15-247),<sup>1</sup> the *Special Access Rulemaking Second Protective Order* in

WC Docket No. 05-25, *et al.*,<sup>2</sup> and under FOIA<sup>3</sup> and the Commission's implementing rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 0.457, 0.459.

Subsequently, it was brought to our attention that some of the text on page 9 of the non-redacted version of CenturyLink's April 8<sup>th</sup> submission was cut off and thus is not reflected in the record. By today's filing, CenturyLink is resubmitting in its entirety the non-redacted version of its April 8<sup>th</sup> submission that shows all of the highly confidential information including the data on page 9.

CenturyLink requests that the confidentiality appendix filed with its April 8<sup>th</sup> submission also apply to the non-redacted version of its submission being re-filed today. The highly confidential information included in the April 8<sup>th</sup> submission is competitively sensitive commercial information that should not be available for public inspection. Its release would have a substantial negative competitive impact on CenturyLink.

CenturyLink is filing two hard copies of today's submission with the Office of the Secretary (one each for WC Docket No. 15-247 and WC Docket No. 05-25/RM-10593) and is providing two hard copies of its non-redacted submission to Marvin Sacks.

Today, CenturyLink is not resubmitting the redacted version of its April 8<sup>th</sup> submission since it had no printing problems (the redacted version can be accessed via ECFS: <https://ecfsapi.fcc.gov/file/60001568985.pdf>).

This letter, which contains no highly confidential information, will also be filed today via ECFS and served via e-mail on the staff that received copies of the April 8<sup>th</sup> submission.
