Description of Planned Network Changes:

AT&T Southeast intends to retire and remove copper feeder facilities in the Ripley WC (**RPLYMSMA**) Route 2 due to a Mississippi DOT road project and provide services over a Digital Loop Carrier (DLC) system that will provide pair gain facilities through feeder fiber. The copper feeder cables that will be removed are connected to XBOXs at the following locations in the Knoxville Main wire center:

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact of the Planned Changes:

After retirement of the copper facilities, AT&T will remove them. All services provisioned over these copper facilities are compatible with DLC systems and will be transferred without consequence except for one competitive carrier UNE that AT&T understands has been used to provide DSL service. This carrier will be notified as required and will be required to make alternative arrangements for the DSL service it provides.
