

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On Wednesday, August 10, 2016, Sue Underwald, Senior Vice President, Business and Legal Affairs, Content Distribution & Marketing for Scripps Networks Interactive (“Scripps”), Kathleen Wallman of Kathleen Wallman, PLLC, outside counsel to Scripps and I, the undersigned, met with David Grossman, Chief of Staff and Media Policy Advisor to Commissioner Clyburn. We explained Scripps’ programming service offerings and our efforts to reach distribution agreements with Online Video Distributors (“OVDs”) and Over-The-Top (“OTT”) distributors. Our efforts are ongoing and we have already achieved some success in this area. We discussed how Alternative Distribution Method and Most Favored Nation clauses operate in the context of agreements with OVDs and OTTs. We also discussed the bundling concerns raised in the Notice of Inquiry, explaining that Scripps does not engage in bundling in the MVPD, OVD or OTT markets.
