
Mr. Chairman,

I've tried to comment on the Internet, but your website doesn't appear to be accepting express comments, so I'm using the good ole US mail.

I urge you to support strong net neutrality by preserving Title II oversight of the Internet Service Providers. A few years ago, you referred to it as an "aberration," but a great many Americans believe, as I do, that the abrogation of Title II that you advocate should be submitted to the rule of the majority.

Allowing blocking, throttling and so-called fast lanes to run without regulations would be akin to pricing mailing fees according to the contents of the letter rather than reasonable criteria of weight and size. The Internet is no different than the post office. The American public should be guaranteed the same access to the Internet as we do with the mail, without favoring one content over another. That freedom is imperative to maintain and protect our democracy.
