The TCPA regulates “telephone line” sent faxes that cause damages. Regular faxing causes the recipient to use paper, toner, wear on the fax machine and also the fax is occupied during a fax transmission” (telephone line is interrupted).

With a digital fax/e-fax that is sent/received via tcp/ip causes zero damages. An electronic transmitted fax does not cause damage per TCPA’s own guidelines as well.

The damage components are removed by e-faxing, there is no violation of the TCPA. Business’s that receive e-faxes elected to have them received via email and NOT faxes. E-faxes can also be sent via tcp/ip, thats not a telephone line so that would not violate the TCPA either.

Digital sent e-fax’s are sent completely differently then a POTS (telephone line) sent fax. The damage components are removed.

I don’t anyone who still receives cost-incurring facsimile machine faxes. I use only digital sent and recived e-faxes. I don’t use a fax machine that uses paper and my e-faxes are never burdening during sending or receiving faxes (I can receive multiple transmissions at once, its better than any fax machine). How anyone can distort the facts is beyond reason and must have other motives to try and say an email is a fax or sending a e-fax through the internet causes the same damages as an old fax machine (that nobody uses anyways).
