On August 8, 2018, pursuant to Rules 51.325 – 51.335, CenturyLink submitted Public Notice 813 for Qwest Corporation for copper retirements associated with wire centers in Afton and Shakopee, Minnesota (involving growth accommodation in outside plant). By today's filing, CenturyLink is amending its submission to extend the implementation date from October 31, 2018 to November 30, 2018. Enclosed with this correspondence are an:

- Amendment to Certification of Public Notice of Network Change Under Rule 51.329(a);
- Amendment to Certification of Public Notice of Copper Retirement Under Rule 51.333; and
