During the meeting, Sprint’s representatives discussed various matters regarding the General Information and Document Request for Sprint that was issued by the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau on August 15, 2018,¹ specifically focusing on document custodians. The representatives also responded to questions from Commission staff regarding the responsibilities of different Sprint employees.
