PLEASE NOTE:

- All references to the Newton MA CS2K switch are associated with CLLI code NWTNMAWAPS0 and will not be repeated throughout this notice.
- All references to the Newton MA C20 switch are associated with CLLI code NWTNMAWAPS1 and will not be repeated throughout this notice.

Description of the Planned Network Change(s):

The Verizon Newton MA CS2K switch located at 787 Washington St., Newton, MA 02160, will be retired and removed from the network after all traffic served by this switch is migrated to the Verizon Newton MA C20 switch located at 787 Washington St., Newton, MA 02160. All traffic to be migrated includes, but is not limited to, Inter-LATA (ACCESS/FG-B-D/CLEC/IXC), wireless, and paging traffic.

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact(s) of the Planned Change(s):

Competitive local exchange carriers (CLECs), interexchange carriers (IXCs, IECs), wireless carriers, and paging carriers will need to secure new trunk groups built to the Newton MA C20 switch. Carriers that are code holders for access connectivity in the Newton MA CS2K switch will be required to reposition the codes to the Newton MA C20 switch.

All ASRs for the Newton MA C20 switch must be received no later than January 18, 2019 in order to provide sufficient time to migrate the traffic described above. These direct end office trunk (DEOT) interconnections will support traffic migration for the Newton MA CS2K switch prior to its eventual decommissioning. Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) change effective dates will be posted prior to decommissioning of the Newton MA CS2K switch (**on or after March 30, 2019**). This will serve to guide interconnect re-routes of traffic for the nine (9) native codes currently served by the Newton MA CS2K switch to reflect the Newton MA C20 switch as the new home switch. All ASRs for the Newton MA C20 switch must carry the project code of **NWTNMAWAPS0**.
