On August 20, 2019, representatives of Maniilaq Association, including the undersigned (collectively, “Maniilaq”), met with Ryan Palmer, Division Chief of the Wireline Competition Bureau’s Telecommunications Access Policy Division (“Division”), and Phil Bonomo, Attorney-Advisor in the Division, to discuss the Request for Review or Limited Waiver filed by Maniilaq on July 2, 2019, in the above-referenced docket. In addition to the undersigned, the representatives of Maniilaq who participated in the meeting (each by phone) consisted of Chad Sheldon, Chief Information Officer; Brad Reich, IT Director; and Elizabeth Hensley of Landye Bennett Blumstein LLP, counsel to Maniilaq.
