**Thank You**, in advance, for reviewing Stratus Networks letter of support.

Our office has reviewed the Railroad Crossing Memorandum submitted to your office by Crown Castle on June 1, 2018. We are in agreement with this memorandum and fully support the statements / conclusions addressed in this document.

Railroad crossing issues continue to be a major obstacle when attempting to install broadband facilities nationwide. The expense and delays by the railroad industry makes broadband deployment unfeasible for smaller markets. Broadband deployment nationwide cannot be completed unless the Federal Communications Commission exercises their authority to stop telecommunications providers from being exploited by the railroad industry.

We respectfully request the Commission exercise its Section 253 authority and preempt state and local laws that allow railroads to act as gatekeepers to the public ROW.
