Per a conversation I had with Mr. Mark Nadel on Friday, August 18, we are supplementing the information that we submitted on 6/6/17 to the FCC in the ECSF format.

We filed a 2016 471 application which was approved on 8/6/16. We didn't discover that one of the circuits had been left off the application until we met with the district in the 4Q 2016, after the 60-day window for filing an appeal was over.

The delay in discovering the missing circuit was due to several issues. Alpine USD had an unusual network design (the hub is not at their District Office) and they changed fiber technologies. In previous years, they only had 6 circuits so when reviewing the application before submitting and after submitting, the missing circuit wasn't discovered. We realized the missing circuit when discussing the new network with the District.

We had not been able to schedule a meeting with the district until 4Q 2016. They had a new Chief Business Officer, who was just getting familiar with the District and she wanted to wait until she hired a Technical Consultant who could be part of the E-rate discussion. After our conversation, we confirmed with an ATT Billing Representative and the ATT bill that when ATT installed Switched Ethernet, they had to add a 7th circuit.

We filed the appeal with USAC on December 6, 2016, which was denied since the 60-day window had passed. We received the RFCDL on 5/30/17 with the denial and filed an FCC appeal on 6/6/17. We included the USAC appeal letter, the contract (attached, for your convenience), showing 7 circuits, the spreadsheet from the ATT representative, showing 7 circuits (attached) and the January bill (attached), showing \$2950.04 for 7 circuits.


We are requesting an increase for just one FRN 1699033593 from \$2595 to \$2950.04 per month.
