During the meeting, the representatives of Sprint and SoftBank discussed various matters regarding the General Information and Document Request that was issued by the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau on August 15, 2018 to the companies,¹ specifically focusing on document custodians, the responsibilities of different employees, and the mechanics of providing the requested information to the FCC.
