I am writing in support of local broadband providers. I use one because I was not getting the service that ATT or Comcast offered at a reasonable price. Comcast was way too expensive and wanted you to bundle everything. ATT capped my network speed based on price. My local ISP, Sonic, provided me with unlimited speed, based on distance, for the same price as ATT.

Sonic could only do that by getting access to the last mile because ATT was forced to let them. If you take that away then you would be killing off the local providers because they don't own the infrastructure.

We should be encouraging competition in ISPs not gaming the system to keep the big boys big.
