Requiring ATT to share the broadband copper and fiber-optics has resulted in superior internet and telephone service offerings for me, my family and my neighbors. Competition in internet service sector is good for consumers and encourages technology improvement and development.

Having internet access is required for modern day function - from simple everyday tasks to doing work for job and school.
