Re: Applications of T-Mobile US, Inc. and Sprint Corporation, WT Docket No. 18-197

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to paragraph 15 of the NRUF/LNP Protective Order issued by the Federal Communications Commission (“Commission”) on July 26, 2018,¹ T-Mobile US, Inc. (“T-Mobile”) hereby notifies the Commission of a request for the disclosure of Numbering Resource Utilization and Forecast (“NRUF”) reports and carrier-specific local number portability (“LNP”) data. T-Mobile received a subpoena from the New York State Attorney General’s Office (“NYAG”) in connection with its review of the pending T-Mobile/Sprint transaction. This subpoena requires that T-Mobile provide “[a]ll Documents . . . received from . . . the Federal Communications Commission (‘FCC’) in connection with the . . . FCC’s investigation of the Proposed Transaction.”² All materials provided to the NYAG are made available to other state attorneys general that are investigating the transaction and that have signed confidentiality agreements with T-Mobile and Sprint (the “Multistate Attorneys General Group”). The Multistate Attorney Generals group has taken the position that T-Mobile is required pursuant to this subpoena to provide access to the NRUF/LNP data certain consultants and counsel received from the FCC.

T-Mobile therefore notifies the Commission of these requests and the intended disclosure of NRUF and LNP data pursuant to paragraph 15 of the NRUF/LNP Protective Order. T-Mobile additionally requests that the Commission issue a Public Notice as expeditiously as possible to notify affected carriers of the potential production of the requested materials.
