Dear FCC,

I chose an alternative to AT&T in my area (Sonic) due to dramatically better service, lack of data caps, lack of traffic shaping (net neutrality) and privacy. I'm not willing to use a provider that targets ads to me based on my network traffic, or replaces ads in parts of the sites that I browse with history based on my targeted usage.

If the ability to compete here is removed, people like myself in an area where other infrastructure is not yet available will be forced to expose their data and deal with dramatically worse service (if you assume broadband is a necessary utility, which hopefully isn't much of a leap).

Please preserve the ability to compete here.
