We are survivors of the October 9, 2017 wildfire that swept through Santa Rosa, California and are now living in a trailer while we wait for our home to be rebuilt.

We selected Sonic while living in our trailer for our telephone and DSL internet service because they are considerably less expensive than AT&T and, like so many other fire victims, we were under insured and need to save every penny that we can to pay for our rebuild.

Broadband internet is critical for us to stay in touch with our contractor and home construction vendors. We would not be able to conduct our daily lives without it.

When we finally move into our rebuilt home we plan to use Sonic fiber for our internet and telephone service because we will need a much higher network speed for our full home needs.

Finally, we are strong proponents for Net Neutrality which is also supported by Sonic and opposed by AT&T.

In closing, please do not take any negative consumer actions that will increase the cost of our Sonic internet and telephone services.
