Dear FCC,

I used to have AT&T DSL, but the performance was terrible. The contract called for up to 60 Mb/s, but in reality that never happened. During peak times in the evening and on weekends, the speeds were so low that I couldn't use YouTube, stream movies, or easily visit websites because the browser would hang. For the same price, I was able to sign up with Sonic Fiber and my life improved immensely. The AT&T speed was measured by Ookla Speedtest as 0.14 Mb/s down and 0.31 Mb/s up, compared to Sonic which was 93.17 Mb/s down and 79.80 Mb/s up.

Please do not let AT&T cut access to the unbundled network lines to cut off the competition and raise prices. They are good at charging money and not delivering the service, which is probably great for profits but terrible for customers who are left without options. The competition that is allowed under current regulations has been good for improving service and infrastructure.
