On Tuesday, August 27, 2019, Steven Metts, General Manager of Valley Telephone Cooperative ("Valley"), and his counsel, Clare L. Andonov and the undersigned with Herman & Whiteaker, LLC, held a telephone conference with Travis Litman, Chief of Staff and Legal Advisor to Commissioner Jessica Rosenworcel of the Federal Communications Commission's (the "Commission"). During the meeting, Mr. Metts discussed the potential waste in the Schools and Libraries ("E-Rate") Program created in the services project awarded for funding year 2019 in the Cochise County Educational Technology Consortium (the "Consortium") in Arizona. The Consortium is seeking special construction costs, in excess of \$29 million dollars, to lay new fiber to reach schools, many of which are already served with existing fiber. Mr. Metts demonstrated that largely due to the construction costs, the proposed project, at minimum, will cost rate payers an additional \$17,873,966 for the eighteen (18) locations currently served by Valley. The parties in general discussed the Petition for Rulemaking in the above captioned proceeding and urged the Commission to release a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking to address the overbuild and waste concerns described in the Petition.
