Dear FCC,

Please do not take away broadband competition by limiting unbundled network elements. Limiting unbundled networks will remove affordable alternatives to people with lower income or for those who like to support local services. Large corporations do not necessarily provide the options desired by the general public in certain areas.

In San Francisco (the whole Bay Area actually), the cost of living is already at an all time high and we who live here are tired of paying double the amount for half the service with larger companies. I have been with AT&T for many years and the service was riddled with instability and high pricing, until I switched over to Sonic.net. At Sonic, I get higher bandwidth for a lower price, and service has been pretty stable. I cannot afford paying nearly \$100 a month for AT&T again on San Francisco minimum wage income.
