Where I live in San Francisco, we actually have competition for internet providers. And it is an amazing experience! My fiber line is so much faster and cheaper than the crappy cable modem and DSL that I had in other cities, and the level of customer support is far superior.

In other cities that I have lived in, internet is only available from one or two monopoly providers, usually regulated utilities. Often their monopoly power is enshrined by law. These monopolies need careful regulation, and competition with them should be encouraged whenever possible.
