I'm a small business owner. We design and build websites for our clients. We use the internet for research, purchasing assets, and communicating with our teams every day, ALL DAY.

We used to have DSL, but when we were able to upgrade to fiber it was a game changer. The speed we have with fiber has now become the norm, and in fact critical to our current and expected work flow and turnaround times. A change to our access or speed would be extremely disruptive to our business. And the potential increase in price would be extremely problematic for us financiallyour margins are already very thin. That's just the nature of our type of business.

Please keep AT&T and USTelecom from taking away access to unbundled networks.
