Holway Telephone Company ("Company") hereby provides notice that it intends to cease offering consumer broadband-only loop (CBOL) service on a tariffed basis under NECA Tariff No. 5. Effective October 3, 2017, the Company will begin offering CBOL service on a Title II, common carriage, permissive detariffed basis pursuant to paragraph 94 of the Federal Communications Commission's Wireline Broadband Order.¹ The geographic areas affected by the change are the Company's exchanges in its study area.

Today, this service is provided to Northwest Communications. The ISP purchases CBOL service for use as a component in its broadband Internet service sold to residential and business customers. End user service provided will not be affected by discontinuance of the tariffed offering by the Company. As stated in the attached customer notice, the Company will continue to offer services to the existing ISP customers under current rates, terms and conditions until at least the end of the customer's present service arrangement.

Effective October 3, 2017, the Company will make its CBOL service available on a permissive detariffed, common carriage basis through posting of rates, terms and conditions available on our website (www.abbmissouri.com) and in printed copy during normal business hours at the Company's business office located at 208 Ash Street, Maitland, MO.

Our records indicate that NW Communications is currently purchasing consumer broadband-only loop service from Holway Telephone Company ("Company") under NECA Tariff No. 5 ("Tariff"). This letter is to advise you that the Company will discontinue provisioning service on October 3, 2017, pursuant to the Tariff. Services will be made available to you on a common carrier, non-tariffed basis. The existing relevant rates, terms and conditions will not change until at least the end of your present service arrangement.

The rates, terms and conditions will be available in printed copy during normal business hours at the Company's business office located at 1605 Washington Street, Blair, NE.

The actions described above are taken in accordance with the FCC's Report and Order (FCC 05-150) released September 23, 2005, in Docket No. 02-33. In this Order, the FCC determined that facilities-based wireline broadband Internet service providers could offer their services on a common carrier, permissively detariffed basis.
