Re: Promoting Technological Solutions to Combat Contraband Wireless Device Use in Correctional Facilities, GN Docket No. 13-111, WT Docket No. 10-4, ET Docket No. 08-73, RM-11430

On August 30, 2016, Prelude Communications representatives, as well as others met with representatives of FCC (OET, HLS and Wireless) to discuss the above-referenced proceedings, provide an industry update and discuss alternative technologies and solutions, which will support preventing contraband communications devices from successfully communicating with the intended devices (individuals) outside the prison used by offenders incarcerated in a correctional facility. A list of meeting attendees is attached.

With almost eight (8) years of hands on experience in trying to combat contraband communication devices, working collaboratively with Correctional Industry, Commercial Carriers and FCC, we are confident that an effective and affordable solution to this problem can be provided which can support correctional agencies budgets, simply the current deployment challenges and be a win for all stakeholders.

During the meeting, the parties discussed the Commission's 2013 NPRM, including complex questions regarding wireless network coverage, services, signaling, the use of on-site appliances similar to manage access, denial of services, assessment solutions (cell detection) and other as a means of combating the use of contraband cell phones in correctional facilities. The parties discussed potential ways to terminate service to a contraband device and 3rd party efforts to control contraband phones through managed access systems, court orders and other process, which might be considered.
