Dear Ms. Dortch:

In accordance with the Public Notice, DA 16-908, released August 10, 2016, in the above captioned proceeding, Brevard Wireless, Inc. dba Florida High Speed Internet (FRN: 0016346991) ("FLHSI") files this comment stating that since June 30, 2015 FLHSI has been providing broadband at 10/1 speeds or greater, with no maximum usage caps for a price which meets the Commission's reasonableness and with latency not exceeding 100ms, in census blocks that are included in the commissions preliminary list. The specified census blocks are listed below and were included in FLHSI's previously filed Form 477.

It is FLHSI's understanding that the Commissions intent is to provide support for broadband deployment only in those "areas that are unserved by any broadband provider." Should a provider receive CAF support to serve an area already served by FLHSI, an unsubsidized competitor, then the Commission's goals of competitive neutrality would be violated and it would undermine FLHSI's significant network investment, which is supported by private citizen capital, in the areas identified.

For the above reasons we respectfully request the identified census tracts be removed from CAF funding consideration.
