
Dear Ms. Searcy:



STATEMENT

Question 9: Page 4

The answer to this question should be amended from "N/A" to "Yes" and the following statement added as "Exhibit 3":

Russ Robinson is General Manager of WHJT(FM), Clinton, Mississippi. Should he be granted the new Construction Permit for Richwood, Louisiana, and prior to the commencement of program test authority, Mr. Robinson will terminate this position and sever all connections with WHJT(FM).

Mr. Robinson also conducts consulting work for other radio stations and teaches communications classes at Mississippi College. Mr. Robinson will also terminate this work.

Exhibit 2

This Exhibit should be amended to include the following "Integration Information" for Mr. Robinson:

Ownership Structure

Mr. Robinson is an individual applicant.

Integration

Should he be granted the new Construction Permit for Richwood, Louisiana, Mr. Robinson will be fully integrated into the management activities of the proposed station.

He will devote full-time, at least forty (40) hours a week to the proposed station as its General Manager. In this capacity, he will be responsible for all duties commonly associated with that position, including, but not limited to: overall supervision of the construction of the station, overall supervision of station operations, news, programming, sales and

public affairs. He will hire and fire all station personnel and will establish and implement all station policies.

Mr. Robinson is currently employed as General Manager of WHJT(FM) in Clinton, Mississippi, he teaches communications classes at Mississippi College and he also conducts consulting work for other radio stations. Prior to the beginning of program test authority for the new Richwood station, Mr. Robinson will terminate his employment with WHJT(FM), his teaching duties at Mississippi College and his consulting work to focus his entire attention on managing the new Richwood facility.

Minority Status, Past Local Residence, Female Status and Daytime Preference

Mr. Robinson will not claim credit under any of these comparative categories. However, should he be granted the new Construction Permit for Richwood and prior to the commencement of program test authority, Mr. Robinson will relocate to a residence in Richwood, Louisiana, in order to effectuate his full-time integration pledge. Mr. Robinson will therefore claim credit for future local residence.

Mr. Robinson has the following broadcast experience:
