On December 9, 1992 Cynthia Brumfield of the National Cable Television Association, and Gene Kimmelman and Mark Cooper of the Consumer Federation of America, met with Robert M. Pepper, Florence Setzer, Ian Martin, Jay Atkinson, Hugh Boyle, Nancy Boocker, and myself of Commission staff, at staff request, to discuss possible collection by the Commission of rate, cost, and other information from cable television systems in connection with MM Docket 92-266.

We discussed possible collection of data concerning general system characteristics, revenue and costs at the system, franchise and corporate level, revenues, service tiers, and rates. We also discussed methodologies that could be used to select samples for collection of data; the extent to which data would be readily available; and the appropriate form, terminology, and structure of a questionnaire.
