ORDER

By the Commission:

1. On December 10, 1992, the Commission adopted Notices of Proposed Rule Making in the above-captioned proceedings involving implementation of the Cable Television Consumer Protection and Competition Act of 1992 (1992 Cable Act). On December 14, 1992, Commission personnel are scheduled to participate in a forum regarding implementation of the 1992 Cable Act sponsored by, among others, the Federal Communications Bar Association. Because the Commission believes participation in this forum by Commission personnel will serve the public interest, we are, on our own motion, waiving the Sunshine Period prohibition contained in our ex parte rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1203, for the limited purpose of permitting participation in the forum by Commission personnel. Any presentations made to Commission decision-makers at the forum in connection with these or other pending proceedings that go beyond written comments or filings must, of course, be disclosed pursuant to the ex parte rules. See 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206.

2. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED THAT, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1203 IS WAIVED to the extent set forth herein.
