Dear FCC,

As someone who uses an ISP that buys wholesale access to telecom copper services, I'm horrified that you might consider lifting the wholesale requirement.

There is VERY little competition in this market for consumers - if ISPs like mine aren't allowed to provide price-competitive services I'd be stuck with either AT&T or Comcast, both of which have terrible customer service.

I'm just looking for basic landline phone service and reasonably fast Internet service, which I get now. If you change the rules about wholesale access, which my local ISP depends upon, my service options will be much worse.

Making the telecom marketplace even more monopolistic than it is today would be a horrible move. Please protect our local ISPs from this proposal by the big telecom companies.
