Dear FCC,

I am a Sonic customer in San Francisco, California. My entire family rely on their fiber optics network. We use it for entertainment, news and work. This service is as important as PG and E. Prior to having fiber, I was a sonic fusion customer. Sonic fusion used ATTs copper wires. The only difference being there was no cap on speed and the price was very affordable.

Sonic is still building its fiber network for other San Franciscans. However, before the completion of their fiber network in San Francisco, most San Franciscans will have to choose between ATT, Sonic (using ATT copper but much cheaper) or Comcast. This new proposal will take away the choice for consumers and most importantly, it will also affect fiber users like me as sonics fiber network still relies on ATTs copper for the backhaul.

Based on my own interest and those of other consumers, I strongly oppose any legislation that may increse price and decrease service.
