
MEMORANDUM OPINION AND ORDER

Issued: December 11, 1992; Released: December 15, 1992

On December 8, 1992, counsel for Deas Communications notified the Commission that discovery was not conducted after HBI's Motion to Reopen the Record and Request for Discovery and Revised Procedural Dates, filed October 22, 1992 was granted. See Memorandum Opinion and Order, FCC 92M-1040, released November 6, 1992. Because discovery was not conducted, requests for examination of witnesses will not be considered again. If any party objects to receiving HBI's exhibits into the record, or if HBI objects to Empire or Deas' exhibits, they should file their objections by December 16, 1992. If objections are made, any response should be filed by December 21, 1992. Proposed findings and conclusions should be filed on January 7, 1992 and replies on January 15, 1992.
