Petitioner Mark Kern, by his counsel, files this status report regarding the above-captioned matter. Mr. Kern is actively participating in the discovery process and plans on serving discovery requests in the near future.

We note that, on the August 30, 2019 deadline for responding to document requests from the Enforcement Bureau ("Bureau"), Entertainment Media Trust ("EMT") filed a motion for an extension of time to respond. Because the discovery request was not served by Mr. Kern, he defers to the Presiding Judge and Bureau to determine whether an extension should be granted. However, the motion demonstrates a pattern whereby EMT continuously seeks to extend the discovery process despite your clear indication that the case should move forward expeditiously. Moreover, we are troubled that the request was filed on the deadline for responding to the Bureau's request.
