ERRATUM TO EX PARTE LETTER RE: WC Docket Nos. 17-84 & 17-108

Dear Secretary Dortch:

On August 31, 2017, Sheba Chacko, Chief Regulatory Counsel for BT in the Americas, and Jennifer Taylor Hodges, Vice President Government Affairs USA, BT Americas, met with Claude Aiken, Wireline Legal Advisor to Commissioner Clyburn to discuss BT Americas' concerns with the Commission's streamlining proposals in Dkt. 17-84 and its proposed actions on net neutrality as outlined in its NPRM in Dkt. 17-108. BT Americas' representatives outlined the concerns as discussed in their reply comments in these dockets.

Later this same day, Sheba Chacko also met with Terri Natoli, Michelle Berlove, John Visclosky and David Brody to discuss BT's concerns about the streamlining proposals in Dkt. 17-84. BT Americas stressed that even the current rules regarding Section 214 applications for discontinuance of services may be insufficient to ensure an orderly, managed transition from TDM to IP services and encouraged the Commission to adopt rules that ensure transparency and a methodical, organized transition.
