I've chosen a competitive ISP because of its overall superior service. For example, there is local, helpful, knowledgeable help by phone whenever I need it. This is in contrast to the TERRIBLE service I used to have with ATT. My CURRENT ISP provides me with a more affordable monthly rate for this GREAT service.

Broadband is a service I can no longer do without at home and in preparing lessons for my work as an educator. My CURRENT ISP also provides better phone service than that provided by the former conglomerate, ATT, with whom I used to have service.
