Dear FCC,

We are Sonic customers when it comes to DSL. As you may know, our choices are limited, but I was happy to get this choice, specifically in our case because Sonic offers a product that our alternative (AT&T, which has a near-monopoly in our area) does not, which is the ability to carry our DSL service over two lines. We've been in our home for 10+ years and AT&T has still not upgraded our street to fiber, so we are forced to have DSL over phone lines. We are too far from the base station (AT&T's reason) to get even 10MBps download speed - even though we must pay for that option in order to get 3 or 4 MBps. If that sounds confusing and unfair, please know that know that we were AT&T customers until we realized there was a better choice.

Please do not take away that choice. Our options are extremely limited already.
