I Nina B. Stewart, hereby swear under penalty of perjury of the laws of Missouri and the United States of America that:

1. I am a director and the secretary of Calvary Educational Broadcasting Network (Calvary).
2. Due to the fact that I am a principal of the station, work at the station on a daily basis, and have lived in the Poplar Bluff area for many years, I have personal knowledge of the complaints lodged against KOKS as well as the geography and topography of the area around the station's transmitter site within the blanketing interference contour site.
3. I have personally plotted the locations of the complainants' homes within the blanketing interference contour on the attached map prepared by the station's engineer, Kevin Fisher. I have plotted the location of these homes to the best of my ability, based on my familiarity with the area and my personal involvement in contacting the complainants and attempting to resolve their complaints.

These locations are of necessity somewhat inexact because of the scale of the map, but I have tried to be as precise as possible by referring to known reference points and typographic features, such as the highway patrol substation near the station's

tower. The numbers used on this map correspond to the numbers used to identify complainants who live in the blanketing interference contour in Calvary's response filed September 22. Those complainants whose complaints involved observed FM blanketing interference are denoted by an asterisk (*).

5. The attached map showing the location of the complainants within the blanketing interference contour is true and accurate to the best of my ability.







I, Charles Lampe, hereby declare, under penalty of perjury of the laws of the United States, that the following is true and correct.

1. I am the owner of "Charley's T.V. Repair" at Route 5, Box 158A, Poplar Bluff, Missouri. I also do contract engineer work for Calvary Educational Broadcasting Network, licensee of KOKS-FM, as well as for other stations in the area.

2. During my work for KOKS I have had an opportunity to discuss Mrs. Doris Smith's interference complaints with her on many occasions. During these telephone conversations, Mrs. Smith has repeatedly told me that she wishes her TV reception to be exactly the way it was before KOKS came on the air, including her reception of WPSD, Channel 6, in Paducah, Kentucky. Because of Mrs. Smith's proximity to the tower, I have been unsure whether her reception of channel 6 could be completely restored. When I informed her of this she has told me, on more than one occasion, that she wouldn't be happy until the tower was moved or the station was off the air.

3. Because of Mrs. Smith's attitude there seemed to be little reason to attempt to resolve her complaints.

4. I also visited the home of Mrs. Hillis in March of 1989 in the company of Mrs. Nina Stewart of KOKS. Mrs. Hillis was not at home, so we spoke with Mr. Hillis. Mr. Hillis had a number of complaints, some of which were very confusing. To make sure that we knew exactly what the station was being asked to correct, I asked Mr. Hillis to write down the kind of interference he was

receiving, doing the best he could to describe that interference.
Mr. Hillis, to my knowledge, never sent this information to
Calvary.



Dear Licensee/Petitioners:

This letter refers to (i) the referenced application for renewal of license filed by station KOKS(FM), Poplar Bluff, Missouri, which commenced operation pursuant to program test authority on September 29, 1988; and (ii) Petitions to Deny filed by Mrs. Hillis and Mrs. Smith which contain numerous complaints of alleged "blanketing" interference caused by the operation of KOKS.

The enclosed computer printout encompasses all persons who allegedly complained about interference from KOKS prior to September 29, 1989, within one year of the program test date. These complaints were received by the Commission's main office in Washington, D.C., the Field Office Bureau in Kansas City, or KOKS(FM). This list includes complainants who noted specific types of interference and does not contain names of persons who (a) complained after September 29, 1989; (b) signed but did not date petitions; or (c) whose complaints lacked sufficient specificity regarding the service interfered with to warrant further action.

We have, as yet, made no final determination in this case concerning the types of service interruptions that fall within the ambit of the Commission's blanketing rule, 47 C.F.R. § 73.318. However, in order to proceed further concerning the alleged blanketing caused by KOKS, the Commission needs to determine preliminarily the exact geographical location of each complainant's residence in relation to the transmitter site. Accordingly, so that the Commission may be more fully informed regarding this matter, you are requested

to plot the location of the residence of each listed complainant on the accompanying maps.¹

Each complainant has been assigned a number. Write that number on the applicable map at the location of the complainant's residence. In those instances where this proves to be impractical because of the confluence of numbers on the same relatively small location, provide a narrative statement to that effect, listing each complainant so located. For example, locate Camelot Estate Mobile Home Court on the map with an asterisk and then provide a list of those complainants located within the mobile home park parameters. For any complainants whose residences are located outside the boundaries of either map, provide a separate statement listing the names and numbers of those complainants.

The Commission further requests that respondents correct any incorrect information contained in the printout, i.e. incorrect spelling of names, addresses or phone numbers. In order to expedite the process, please make all corrections in the margin or in the space directly underneath the complainant's name.

Additionally, the Commission has enclosed copies of petitions not appearing on the printout because of illegible writing. If possible, return the petitions, with the clarifying information, and they will promptly be included in a supplemental printout.

By way of explanation, our reason for enclosing a comprehensive list of all complainants is because a licensee owes different obligations to complainants whose service disruption is within the scope of the rule, based not only on the time and nature of the complaint, but also on the exact geographical location of each complainant. The FM Broadcast Station Blanketing Interference Report and Order 41 Fed.Reg. 45142 (Nov. 15, 1984), states that licensees must provide technical assistance in determining the cause of the interference problems and provide advice on corrective measures to complainants who experience interference beyond the blanketing area perimeter, (Paragraph 17). New stations owe a full financial duty to correct blanketing interference complaints from inside the contour received within one year of the program test date, (Paragraph 22). Complaints filed after the one year period are covered by the same rules as blanketing interference complaints for existing stations, (Paragraph 22). Thus, a new station has an obligation to

¹ The Commission earlier received a plotted map, dated October 13, 1989, from KOKS. The similar plotting requested on the additional maps enclosed herewith is required in order to determine more fully the exact location of all the complainants alleging interference problems. Because of difficulties concerning the legibility of the October map, and the dispute between the parties concerning its completeness, the Commission requests that the numbers of all listed complainants be plotted on the original maps enclosed herewith.
