Network Change:

BellSouth Telecommunications LLC. d/b/a AT&T Louisiana is announcing that the Alcatel-Lucent 1AESS switch at Lafayette Main (**LFYTLAMACG0**) is being replaced with a GENBAND switch utilizing a G6/G5 architecture. The cutover is scheduled on or after the 2nd or 3rd Qtr 2017 and will not be implemented prior to April 29, 2017.

Description of Type of Changes Planned:

The purpose of this Network Disclosure is to provide information on the Lafayette Main Transfer Project and Dial with Dial plans. The Lafayette Main 1A ESS switch serves two functions: 1) local end office LFYTLAMACG0, and 2) local tandem LFYTLAMA04T.

AT&T Southeast is replacing the existing Alcatel Lucent 1AESS standalone end office switch with a new Genband switch utilizing a GENBAND G6/G5 architecture. The GENBAND switch is configured to accept trunking in TDM format only. The new LFYTLAMAPSA switch will also home on LFYTLAMA0GT (Lafayette Main) for FG B, FG D and Intra Lata tandem functions.

Lafayette Main (LFYTLAMACG0) switch currently homes on the LFYTLAMA0GT (Lafayette Main) Operator Services Tandem.

The new LFYTLAMAPSA location will also home on the LFYTLAMA0GT (Lafayette Main) Operator Services Tandem.

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact of the Planned Changes:

AT&T Southeast, Independent LECs, Wireless Service Providers, IXC, and CLECs will be affected for traffic originating and terminating to and from end office Lafayette Main (LFYTLAMACG0).
All existing trunking to Lafayette Main local tandem (LFYTLAMA04T) should be disconnected, and that traffic routed to Direct End Office, or Access Tandem Trunks.
All existing trunking to Lafayette Main local end office switch (LFYTLAMACG0), can be migrated to the LFYTLAMAPSA switch.
Independent LECs, Wireless Service Providers, IXC, and CLECs must **(a)** determine whether to establish new trunk groups to LFYTLAMAPSA, if appropriate, and **(b)** evaluate whether their existing trunk groups to LFYTLAMA0GT (Lafayette Main Tandem) are adequate to handle the LFYTLAMAPSA traffic.
ASR/LSRs for Traffic on the LFYTLAMA04T is requested by 1/27/2017.
