Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pilot Butte Transmission Company, Inc. (“Pilot”), a common carrier station licensee, hereby notifies the Commission, pursuant to Section 22.321 of the Commission’s rules, that it has never had any employees nor any employment complaints filed against it.

Inasmuch as Pilot has no employees, and Instruction A (“Who Must File”) to the Form 395 indicates that “[t]he FCC Form 395, Common Carrier Annual Employment Report, is to be filed by all licensees and permittees of common carrier stations with sixteen (16) or more full time employees . . .”, Pilot has properly refrained from filing the Form 395 on an annual basis.

Given its lack of employees, it follows that no employment complaints were filed against Pilot, however, Pilot never formally advised the Commission of that fact. Out of an abundance of caution, Pilot is now formally notifying the Commission that there have been no employment complaints failed against it during the timeframe it has been a licensee. To the extent deemed necessary, Pilot respectfully requests a waiver of Section 22.321(c) of the Commission’s Rules to permit the filing and acceptance of the instant report. Such a grant would be in the public interest, as it would enable Pilot, a company with no employees, to formally advise the Commission of that fact.
