Without competition in my area there would be only one high speed option, Comcast. They charged me twice as much before a fiber competitor came into the area for 1/10th the speed. As soon as the fiber option became available they lowered prices and increased speeds, so they could have done this the whole time but chose not to. Without this connection working from home wouldn't be possible. I need the fast connection to be able to work live with people across the globe in a responsive way. My only other options are a 2 hour commute to get faster connection at my job, or pay 10x the price for a dedicated OC3 fiber line.
